Who is eligible to apply?

In order to apply for this scholarship you must be:

- Currently in year 13 and applying to university for the 24/25 academic year
- Have a household income of less than £35,000 (as assessed by Student Finance this means you must be eligible for and applying to Student Finance (England) for funding. Whilst your application does not need to have been approved yet for you to apply for the scholarship, you will need to share your income assessment as conducted by Student Finance to progress to interview stage)
- You are predicted to achieve 3 A-levels grades 1-3 or equivalent (and you must achieve this)
- You must be a UK student. International students are not eligible
- The scholarship is open to full time students enrolled on their first undergraduate degree, in any discipline except vocational degrees (i.e. Architecture, Medicine, Drama/ Performing Arts, etc.)


